MEDICAL CARE TO CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

Kathu Solar Park in partnership with Uhambo Foundation and the Department of Health commenced with the implementation of the Capacity Building for Children with Disabilities programme.

The objective of this programme is to enable the accessibility of occupational and physiotherapy services to rural and remote beneficiaries who typically cannot access centralized clinics. A key enabler is the provision of transportation of medical workers to homes of disabled children to allow these children easy access to the required therapy.



WORKING WITH PARTNERS

In support of the Provincial Department of Health's vaccination programme in and around the Kathu and Kuruman areas, Kathu Solar Park joined the Northern Cape Shared Value Initiative in a successful Public Private Partnership to support the COVID-19 vaccination drive.

Our collaborative effort meant that in the midst of the pandemic, personal protective clothing including 10 000 disposable gowns, coverall body suits, respiratory and surgical masks, and safety goggles for eye protection were donated through the Department of Health, to local state hospitals and other medical facilities.

This initiative meant that the risk of COVID-19 transmission among medical staff in the Kuruman Hospital and the Tshwaragano Community Hospital in Batlharos as well as community members was significantly reduced.

Going forward, the focus of collaborative initiatives will include education and skills development, and health.

BABATAS WATER PROJECT

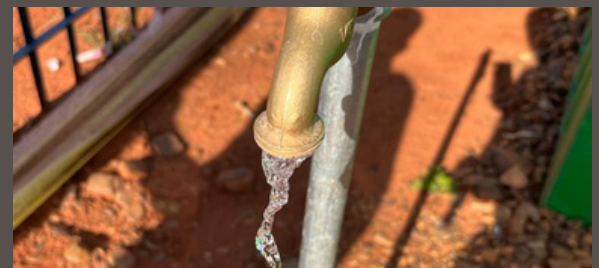
Kathu Solar Park partnered with Sishen Iron Ore Company-Community Development Trust (SIOC-CDT) to provide the community of Babatas, in Kathu, with safe drinkable water. **We will deliver bulk water capacity to +/- 600 households and reticulation to +/-300.**

This is an essential programme, considering the community lack access to safe drinking water as they are not connected to municipal bulk services such as water and electricity. Water is important for personal and agricultural use and is an ongoing challenge.

SIOC-CDT is leading the design, procurement, permitting, construction, and overall project management of this project. This is one of the biggest water projects undertaken by Sishen Iron Ore Company-Community Development Trust.

Working in partnership with Gamagara local municipality and the Babatas Community Property Association, the initiative was officially launched, on 28 October 2020.

The buffer tank with the fencing and the steel for the elevated tank including the bulk and reticulation pipe has been completed, and the construction is expected to finish by November 2022.
