A YEAR OF POSITIVE CHANGE

Our in-school breakfast programme, in partnership with the Tiger Brands Foundation and the DBE, has supported almost 4,500 learners in and around Kuruman, one year after implementation. The programme complements the National School Nutrition Programme, which supports learners in quintile 1–3 schools across the country.

During recent visits to the five schools benefiting from the programme, principals shared the positive impact on learner attendance, punctuality, concentration, and overall well-being—particularly for those lacking financial resources.

Learners receive nutritious, fortified porridges prepared in clean, well-equipped kitchens by trained food handlers.

"This programme has not only benefitted the learners in terms of guaranteeing their day starts on a full stomach, but it also encourages learners to attend school early, regularly." - Principal B.G. Magome, Bankhara-Bodulong Primary School.
